Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM) Video Challenge

What is consent?

Consent is more than just asking—it is about listening to and accepting the answer without pressuring someone to change their mind.

I ASK is the statement by which individuals demonstrate that asking for consent is a healthy, normal, and necessary part of everyday interactions.



Details

WHAT

- Create a 2-3 minute video that demonstrates what consent means to you.
- Video must be original.
- Video must be appropriate for all audiences and not contain any explicit content.
- Videos can be produced individually or as a group.
- Participants must be 14 and older.

HOW

- Deadline for submission: March 15, 2019
- Submit video to SAAMvideochallenge@gmail.com
- Submissions must include names of participants, age, phone number, and city
- Submitted videos will be disseminated by Freedom House at their discretion

WHY

If selected, your video will raise awareness within your community about the importance of consent via:

- social media
- news broadcasts
- cinema previews
- public events

The video judged best overall will receive additional recognition and a prize.
